Guidelines for the Scholarship for Outstanding Student Club Officers

Approved on June 12, 2014 (2nd Student Affairs Meeting, Academic Year 2013)

Article 1

To encourage students to actively participate in student club activities, cultivate a spirit of service, promote personal growth, and broaden their international perspective—thereby nurturing well-rounded individuals with both technical skills and moral integrity—these guidelines are hereby established.

Article 2 – Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet one or more of the following conditions:

1. Have served as an officer of a student club that received a Grade A or higher in an evaluation conducted by the Ministry of Education or the University.
2. Be a former officer of an outstanding student club and remain actively involved in or supportive of club activities.
3. Have served as an officer in a student self-governance organization or athletic team with outstanding performance.
4. Have provided significant support in major university events and demonstrated excellent performance.
5. Possess special talents (e.g., in languages, music, fine arts, literature, athletics, or other areas of distinction).
6. Be recommended by a faculty member or administrative unit of the University.

Article 3 – Selection Procedure

Students must complete and submit an application form to the Extracurricular Activities Section. After an initial review by relevant units of the Office of Student Affairs, applications are forwarded to the Selection Committee for deliberation and submitted to the University President for final approval. Selected students will be eligible to participate in international cultural exchange programs organized by the University.

Article 4

The scholarship amount for each recipient may be adjusted based on the cost of the destination country or region. This scholarship is a designated fund and shall only be used for participation in the exchange program; it is not distributed as a monetary award.

Article 5

Applications are accepted once per academic year through an open announcement. The number of recipients and total funds may be adjusted depending on actual conditions and the University's budget.

Article 6

These guidelines shall be implemented following approval by the Student Affairs Meeting and ratification by the University President. The same applies to any future amendments
