

National Yunlin University of Science and Technology, student dormitory life autonomy committee outstanding members of the residence fee discount key points

6/30/109 Adopted at the 9th Executive Council meeting of the 108th school year.

1. In order to encourage students to take the initiative to participate in student dormitory services and to develop the spirit of enthusiastic service to the public, this course has been established according to the third point of this university's student dormitory management.

2. Discount Targets: Students who are members of the Student Residence Life Committee.

3. Conditions and amount of discount

(1) Students who have served as members of the Student Residence Life Committee during the semester with outstanding performance and have passed the examination at the end of the semester will be given a discount on the full price of the air-conditioned room for that semester, with the maximum number of students to be discounted being ten.

(2) Students who are members of the Dormitory Life Committee with outstanding performance and pass the examination at the end of the semester will be given a discount according to the grades of the examination scores, and the maximum number of members to be discounted will be two-thirds of the total number of members in the semester, with the grades as follows:

- A. Students who receive an evaluation score between 90 and 99 will receive a 60% reduction in air-conditioned room accommodation fees for the semester.
- B. Students who receive an evaluation score between 80 and 89 will receive a 50% reduction in air-conditioned room accommodation fees for the semester.
- C. Students who receive an evaluation score between 70 and 79 will receive a 40% reduction in air-conditioned room accommodation fees for the semester.
- D. Students who receive an evaluation score between 60 and 69 will receive a 30% reduction in air-conditioned room accommodation fees for the semester.

(3) The amount of the discount is calculated on the basis of the accommodation fee for the air-conditioned room type for that semester, but not exceeding the individual's accommodation fee for that semester.

4. Evaluation and Approval Procedure: The preliminary evaluation shall be conducted by the Discipline Section of the Office of Student Affairs. The final list of recipients and the corresponding discount rates shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of Student Affairs Executive Meeting. The discount shall be granted once at the end of each semester.

5. Funding for this element will be covered under Student Housing.

6. These guidelines shall be implemented following approval by the Administrative Council and ratification by the President. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
